


MP3 url for audio stream plugins using Archive.org By: Mason's App Designs

1. Select which server to store audio files on and create an account. (I use <https://archive.org> it is free and works well and others should be similar.)





2. You need to upload your audio files to the archive server by using the upload button by the red arrow.

3. Once you go to the next screen you will click on the "classic uploader" button and select which audio files to upload.


NOTE: If you name your files using all lowercase and underscores it will make it much easier when using the plugins later on. (abc_123.mp3). Don't mix upper and lowercase and do not use spaces.

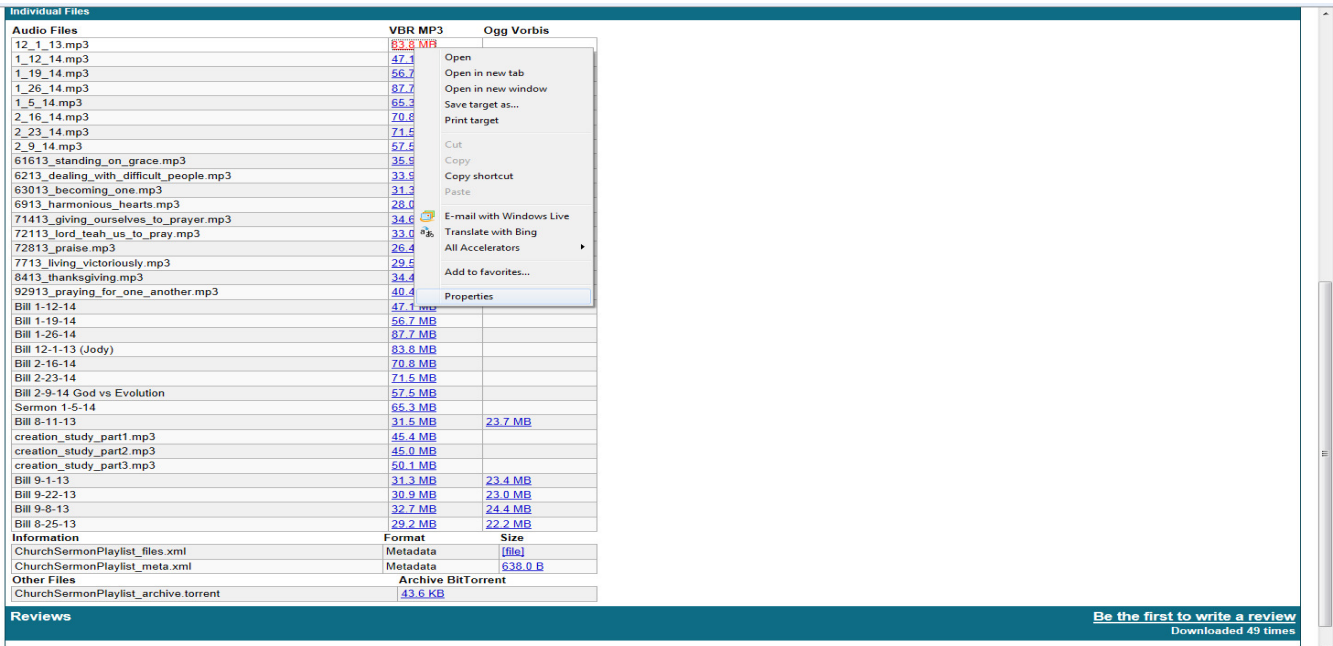
4. Once the audio files are uploaded you will need to create a title for you group of file, a description, and add in keywords. Once completed click "share my files".

Note: Make sure these are your files and not copyrighted audio files.

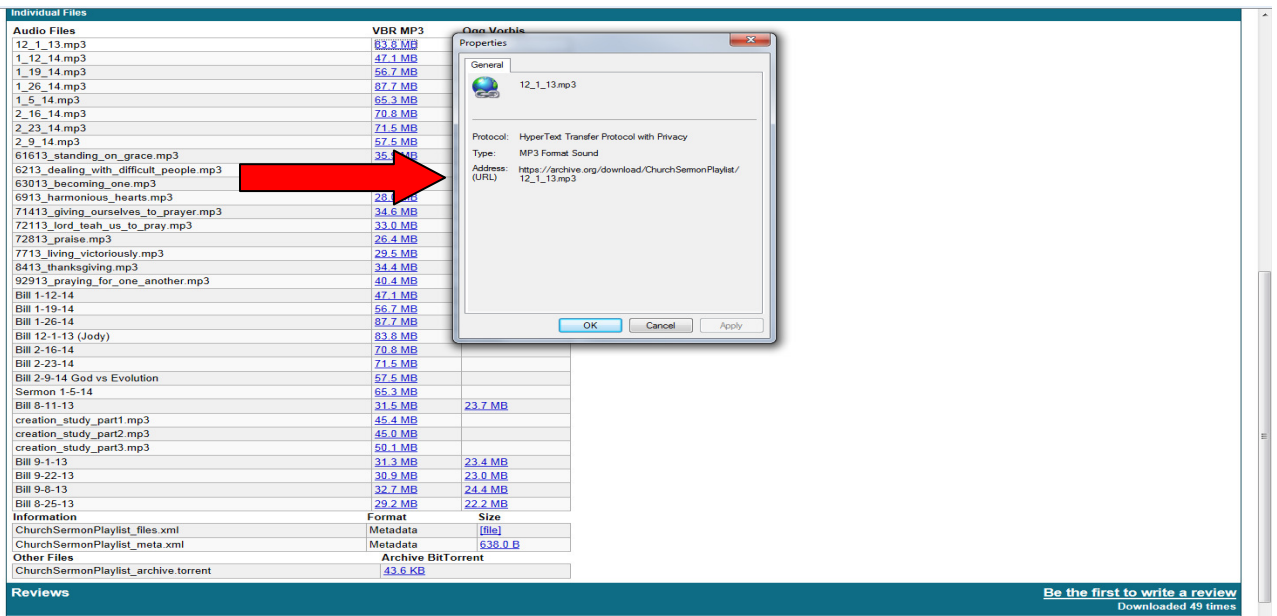

5. You can now go to your downloaded files to get the mp3 url.



6. You will right click on the blue file size under the mp3 format and select properties.



7. Copy the .mp3 url next to address and paste into url file location within the plugin and you are done just complete the other info with the plugin you need (screen name, etc...). Should work for both CP Stream and Audio Stream Plugins.

ADDING FILES:

If you need to add files to the group:

- You click on edit item on the left of the screen.
- Click "I want to change the file"
- You can now click on "classic uploader" and add more audio files to that group.
