Use the links on the left to control how your application behaves, what it looks like, and what features it includes. Each application is a collection of **Menus and Screens** that can be arranged in literally thousands of ways.

**It's best to design and build your app with the iOS Simulator or Android Emulator Running.** Running the simulator while you make changes on the control panel allows you to see the changes in real-time. Use the refresh button (see graphic) on your app's home screen while you're designing the app.

**Themes, Tabs, and Home Screens** control your applications look, feel, functionality and performance.

**Themes** allow you to make global changes to your app's look, feel, and layout. Any screen can override the global theme to account for exceptions and small design details.

**Home Screens** are used as anchors to core content and navigation structures. If your application uses a tabbed layout, each tab is configured with an icon, a title, a screen to use as it's home screen, and an optional sound effect to play when the tab is selected.

**Menus and Screens** make up the bulk of your app. Most of the work you do designing your app will be related to creating and connecting screens. A Menu as the home screen is an additional n

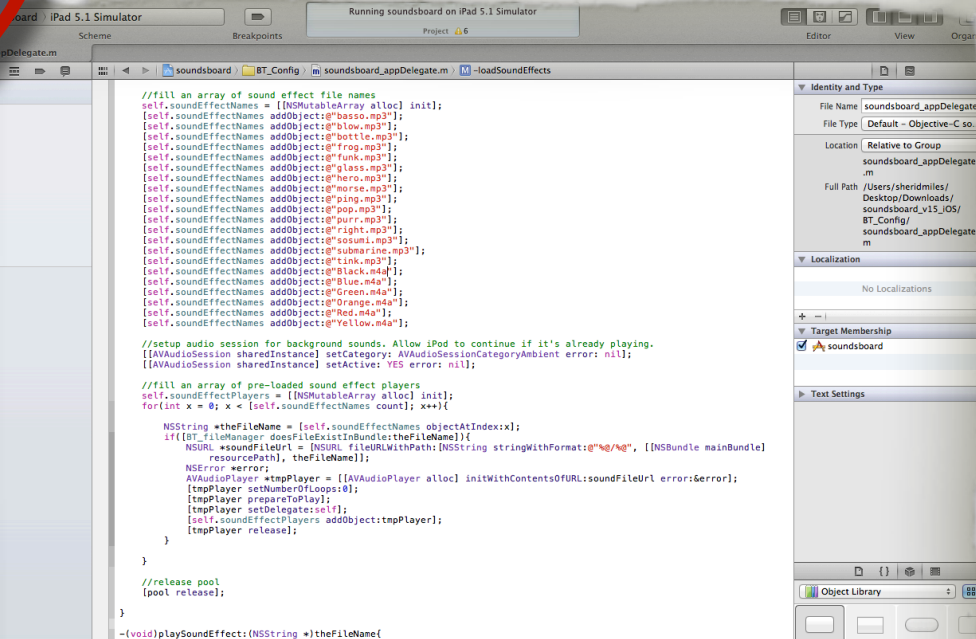


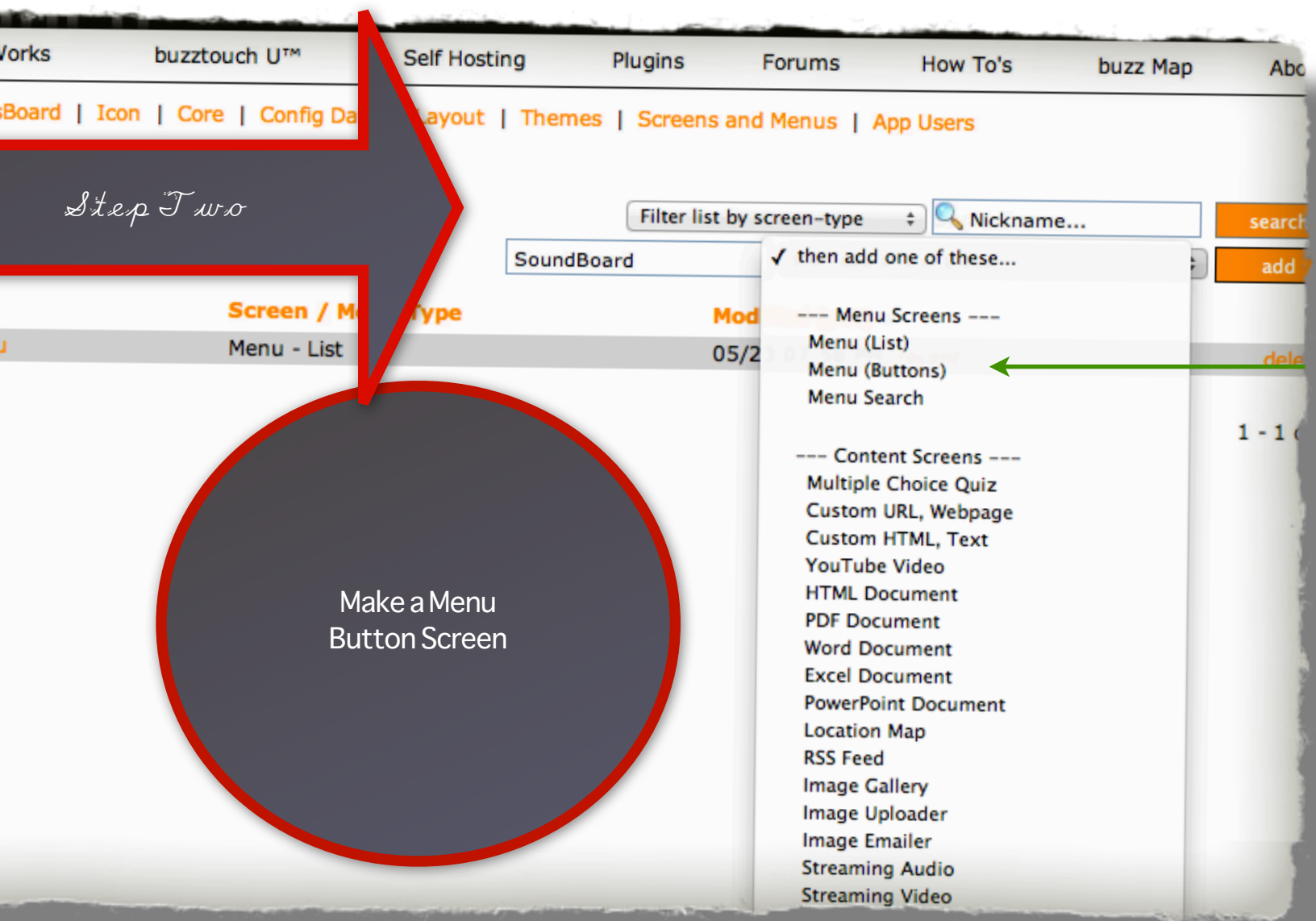

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**Menus and Screens** make up the bulk of your app. Most of the work you do designing your app will be related to creating and connecting screens. Most applications use a Menu as the home screen. Tapping items on the home screen menu usually loads additional menus and content.

## About App Layouts

Applications can have a single home-screen, or up to 5 home screens if they use a tabbed layout.

Generally speaking, tabbed layouts are best for apps that have lots of content. Light, simple home screen that serves as the main-menu for the app. Items in the home screen menu...

**To create a non-tabbed layout,** expand the Home Screen section below and choose one (or more) screens to use as the home screen (or screens) for your app. Be sure to create a screen to select from your **Screens and Features list** before continuing. If you do not create a screen, you won't be able to complete the configuration.

**To use a tabbed layout,** configure up to 5 tabs below in the "Tabbed Layout Options" section. If you are using a tabbed layout, use entries blank. You'll need to create the home screens in your **Screens and Features list** before you can complete the configuration. If your design uses less than 5 tabs, leave the entries blank.

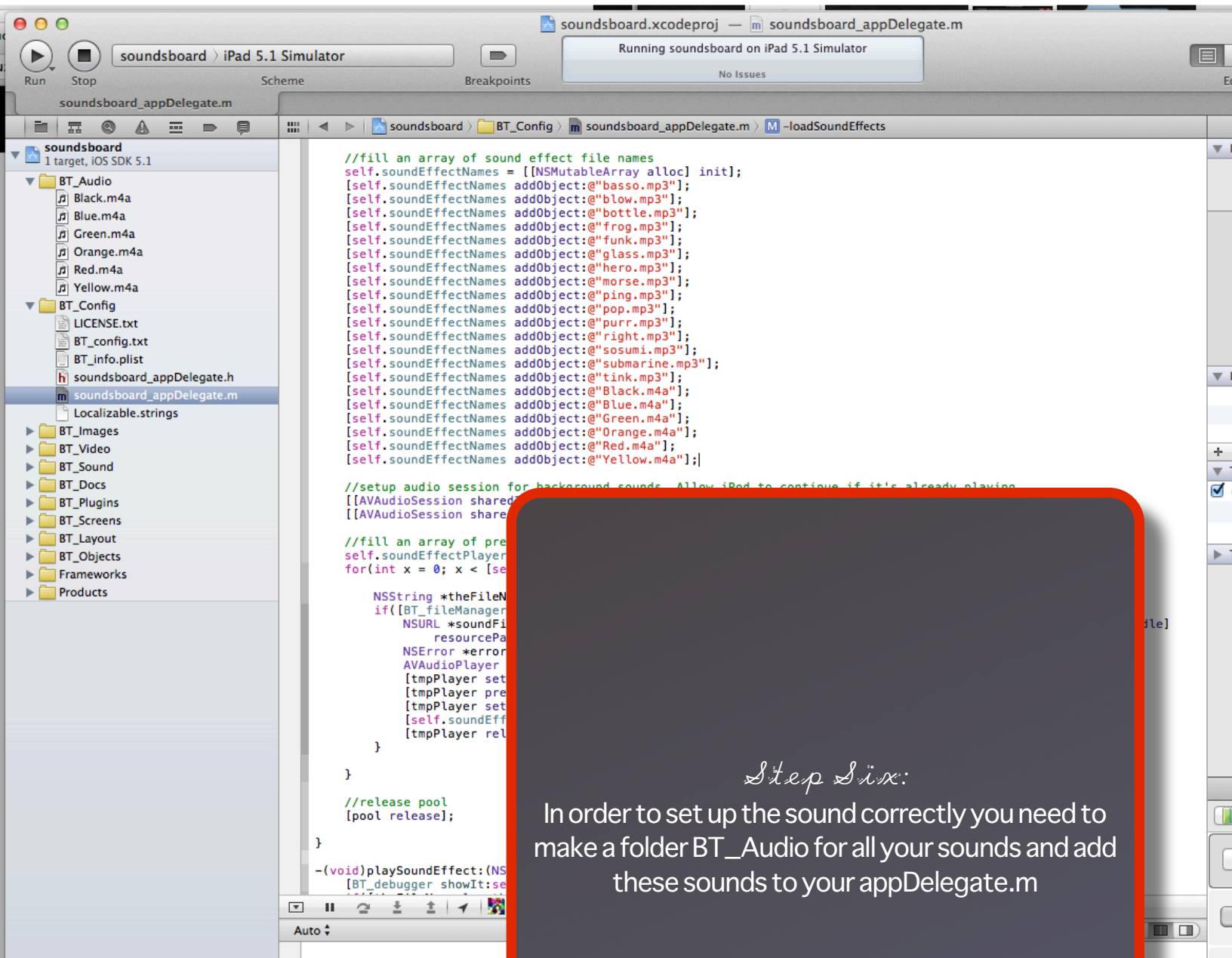

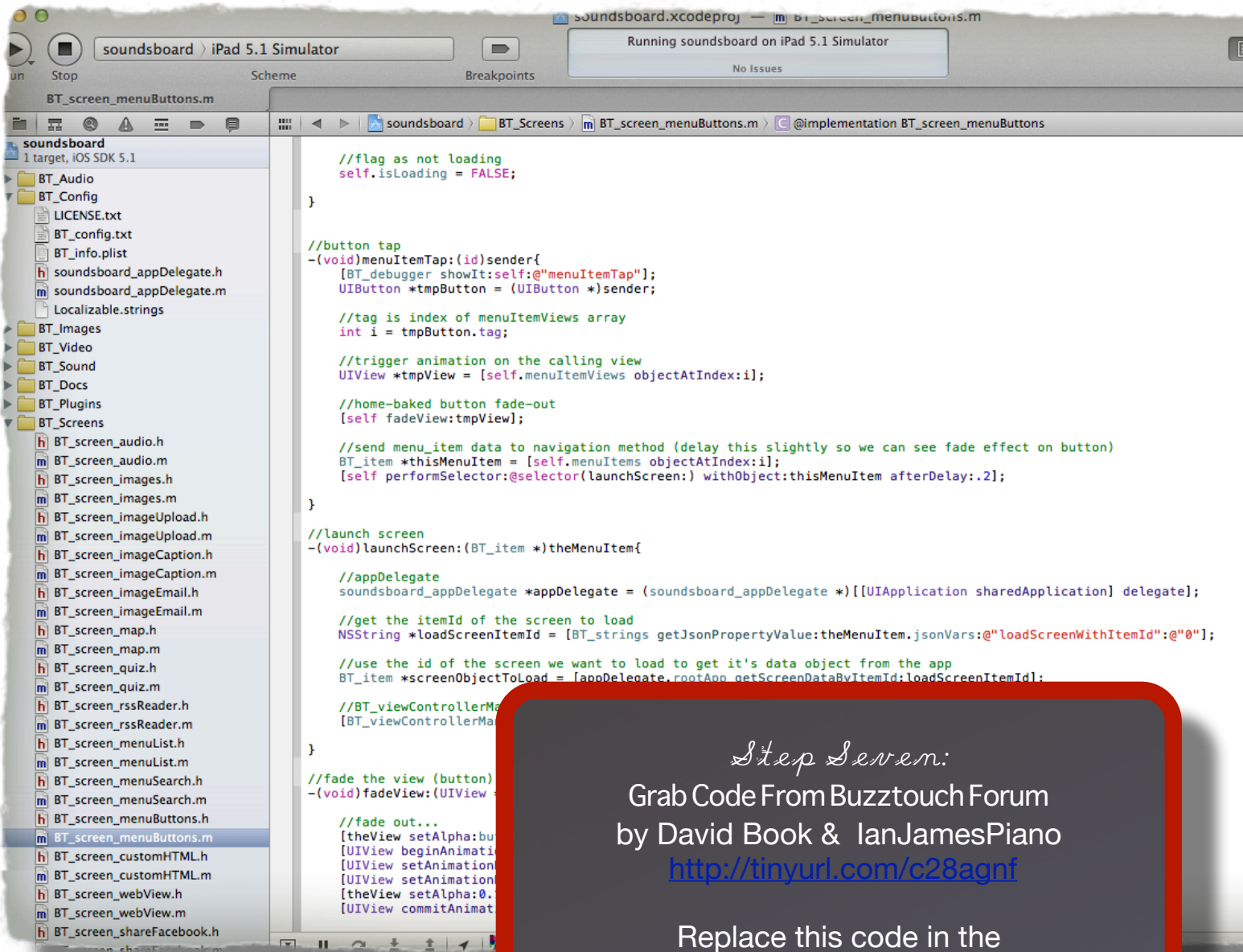

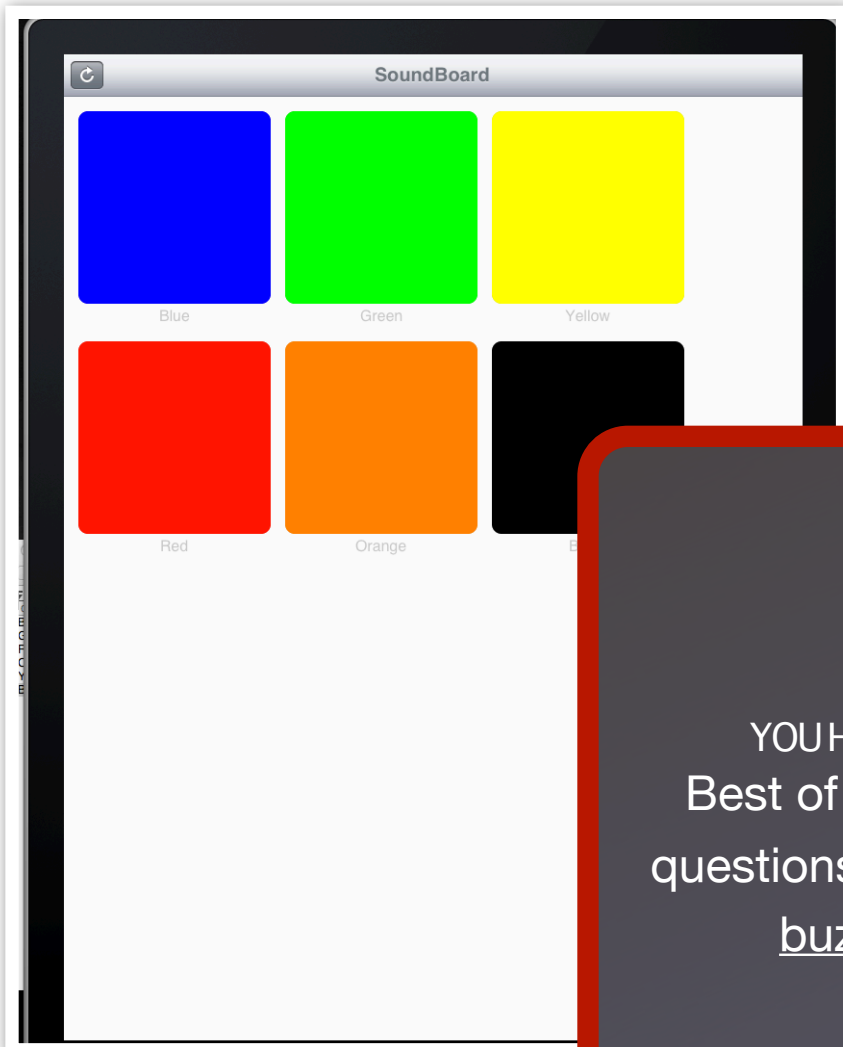
